
# What is zoom?

Zoom is a digital tool that lets you have video-based calls with friends and family.




Learning how to use **zoom** can take practice. But **don't worry**: this guide is here to help you!





2) Search for "Zoom Cloud Meetings"



3) Press "Get" and follow the Instructions to enter your Apple ID passcode or Touch ID








4) Then, press "Open"







# Did the host of your call send you a *Meeting ID*?


(hint: it's a number that looks like XXX XXXX XXXX)




Press "Join Meeting"



Press and type (or paste in!) the Meeting ID, then your name.








### Entering the **Zoom** call

The first time you join a call, make sure you allow Zoom "permissions" to work properly!






You've joined the call, and can now start talking!

Your microphone is off on this mode, swipe right to exit.


#### SPEAKER VIEW


See the video only of the person who is speaking in the call.


#### **GALLERY VIEW**






